200% of Poverty Income Standards

Below are the charts outlining 200% of Poverty income levels for family size for the program years June 1, 2011 through May 31, 2012 and June 1, 2009 through May 31, 2011 (**please note that for the year 2010, the amounts did not change.**). Districts will be notified annually of the 200% of Poverty income standards.
